2. One monkey swings on a vine. Two monkeys join it. How many jungle-animals total? $1 + 2 = ?$

3. Four parrots sit in the jungle tree. Two parrots land on a branch. How many jungle-animals now? $4 + 2 = ?$

4. Three snakes slither through jungle grass. Four snakes join them. How many jungle-animals slither? $3 + 4 = ?$

5. Five tigers rest in the jungle shade. Two tigers wake up. How many jungle-animals are there? $5 + 2 = ?$

6. Six zebras drink from the jungle water. Three zebras come closer. How many jungle-animals altogether? $6 + 3 = ?$

7. Seven crocodiles swim in the jungle river. Two more crocodiles swim near. How many jungle-animals in water? $7 + 2 = ?$

8. Eight wild elephants walk through the jungle. Two baby elephants follow them. How many jungle-animals walk together? $8 + 2 = ?$

1. Two lions sit together. Three more lions join them. How many jungle-animals are there? $2 + 3 = ?$

Answer: 5

2. One monkey swings on a vine. Two monkeys join it. How many jungle-animals total? $1 + 2 = ?$

Answer: 3

3. Four parrots sit in the jungle tree. Two parrots land on a branch. How many jungle-animals now? $4 + 2 = ?$

Answer: 6

4. Three snakes slither through jungle grass. Four snakes join them. How many jungle-animals slither? $3 + 4 = ?$

Answer: 7

5. Five tigers rest in the jungle shade. Two tigers wake up. How many jungle-animals are there? $5 + 2 = ?$

Answer: 7

6. Six zebras drink from the jungle water. Three zebras come closer. How many jungle-animals altogether? $6 + 3 = ?$

Answer: 9

7. Seven crocodiles swim in the jungle river. Two more crocodiles swim near. How many jungle-animals in water? $7 + 2 = ?$

Answer: 9

8. Eight wild elephants walk through the jungle. Two baby elephants follow them. How many jungle-animals walk together? $8 + 2 = ?$

Answer: 10
