VOCABULARY

PERSUADE — to convince someone to believe or do something

INFORM — to give someone facts or information

ENTERTAIN — to amuse or interest an audience

EXPLAIN — to make something clear or easy to understand

EVIDENCE — facts or information that proves something

REASON — the purpose or cause for something

CONVINCE — to make someone certain about something

DESCRIBE — to tell what something is like in detail

SUPPORT — to provide facts that back up an idea

CLAIM — a statement that something is true

DETAILS — small pieces of information that help explain

EDUCATE — to teach or provide learning to others
