## VOCABULARY

**METAPHOR** — A comparison between two things without using 'like' or 'as'

**SIMILE** — A comparison between two things using 'like' or 'as'

**PERSONIFICATION** — Giving human qualities to non-human things

**IMAGERY** — Descriptive language that appeals to the five senses

**HYPERBOLE** — An extreme exaggeration used for emphasis or effect

**SYMBOLISM** — Using objects or actions to represent deeper meanings

**ALLITERATION** — Repetition of beginning sounds in nearby words

**ONOMATOPOEIA** — A word that imitates the sound it represents

**IDIOM** — A phrase with a meaning different from its literal words

**IRONY** — When something happens opposite of what is expected

**PUN** — A play on words that uses multiple meanings

**THEME** — The main message or lesson in a story
