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VOCABULARY

METAPHOR — comparing two things by saying one thing IS another

SIMILE — comparing two things using like or as

IMAGERY — descriptive language that appeals to the five senses

PERSONIFICATION — giving human qualities to non-human things

HYPERBOLE — extreme exaggeration used for effect

ALLITERATION — repetition of beginning consonant sounds in nearby words

ONOMATOPOEIA — a word that imitates the sound it represents

SYMBOLISM — using objects or actions to represent deeper meanings

PUNS — clever plays on words with multiple meanings

IRONY — when something happens opposite to what is expected

IDIOM — a phrase or expression that means something different from its literal words

THEME — the main message or lesson of a story
