VOCABULARY

NARRATOR — the person telling the story

PERSPECTIVE — the way someone sees or understands things

FIRSTPERSON — telling a story using I, me, we, us

THIRDPERSON — telling a story using he, she, they, it

CHARACTER — a person in a story

FEELINGS — emotions or how someone is affected

THOUGHTS — ideas or beliefs in someone's mind

DESCRIBE — to tell what something is like

EXPERIENCE — something that happens to someone

VIEWPOINT — the position from which someone sees things

OPINION — what someone believes or thinks

EVIDENCE — facts or examples that support an idea
