VOCABULARY

NARRATOR — the person telling the story

CHARACTER — a person in a story

PERSPECTIVE — the way someone sees or understands something

FEELING — an emotion or sensation someone experiences

OPINION — what someone thinks or believes about something

THOUGHT — an idea in someone's mind

BELIEVE — to think something is true

OBSERVE — to watch and notice something carefully

DESCRIBE — to tell what something is like using words

VIEWPOINT — a person's particular way of looking at things

EMOTION — a strong feeling like happiness or sadness

VOICE — the unique way an author or character expresses themselves
