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VOCABULARY

CIRCLE — A round shape with no corners

TRIANGLE — A shape with three sides and three corners

SQUARE — A shape with four equal sides and four corners

RECTANGLE — A shape with four sides and four corners, longer than wide

SIDE — A line that forms the edge of a shape

CORNER — The point where two sides of a shape meet

SHAPE — A flat or solid form with a specific outline

SPHERE — A round solid shape like a ball
