VOCABULARY

ADDEND — a number being added in an addition problem

EQUALS — the same value; shown by the = sign

PLUS — the addition symbol; means to put together

SUM — the answer to an addition problem

TENS — groups of ten in a number

ONES — single units in a number

REGROUP — to bundle ten ones into a ten

COMBINE — to put two groups together
