VOCABULARY

ONES — the rightmost place in a number

TENS — the second place from the right in a number

HUNDREDS — the third place from the right in a number

ROUND — to change a number to the nearest ten or hundred

DIGIT — any single numeral from 0 to 9

NUMBER — a quantity or amount

PLACE — the position of a digit in a number

VALUE — how much a digit is worth based on its place

COMPARE — to decide if numbers are greater, less, or equal

ESTIMATE — to make a reasonable guess of a number
