VOCABULARY

SKELETON — the framework of bones that supports an animal's body

MUSCLES — body tissues that help animals move and function

CLAWS — sharp curved nails that help animals grab and climb

FANGS — long sharp teeth used for hunting and defense

WINGS — body parts that allow birds and insects to fly

TAIL — an extension at the rear used for balance and movement

SCALES — hard protective plates covering reptile and fish bodies

FEATHERS — lightweight structures that cover birds for flight and warmth

TEETH — hard structures in the mouth used for biting and chewing

SKIN — the outer covering that protects an animal's body
